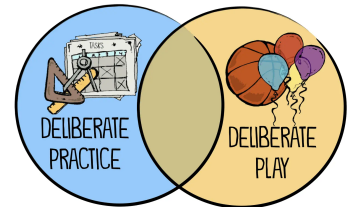

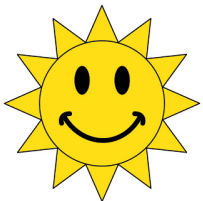
Goals

Add deliberate play to practice.

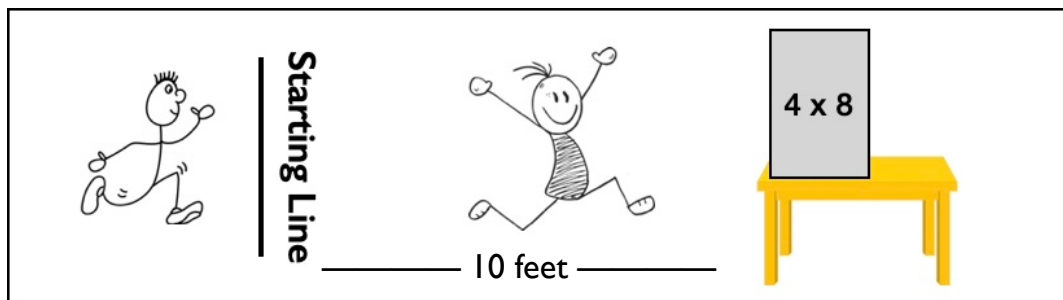


**Start now. Make it A Summer to Remember!**
