- * You can choose individual facts and set a time limit per answer. This encourages students to stop counting, and learn the facts.
- * When students are studying, no time limit is needed. If they do not know a fact, they can look at the *back of the card* to view strategies and graphics that help them understand and remember facts.
- * When children have learned the facts, they show their parents. It takes seconds.
- * Children like using FastFacts Math. They don't shoot bad guys or aliens, but like arcade games, they have a goal, a mission: to answer 10 facts in 30 seconds.
- * Each time children meet a challenge, their parents can enter them in a contest. This adds fun and more motivation.
