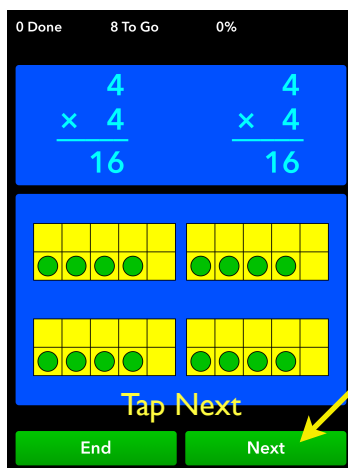
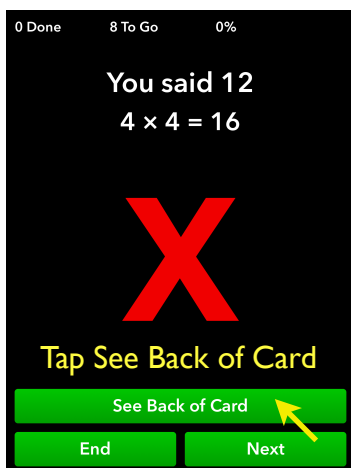


Trust your first response.

If Incorrect



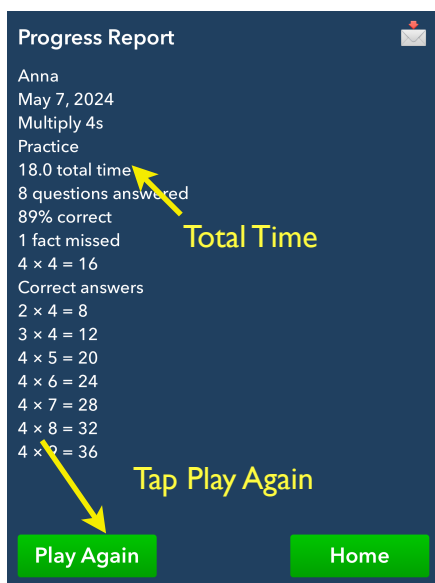
Look at the graphics.

When to advance to the next list.



When you know the facts really well, you can answer eight facts in less than 20 seconds.

Do not worry if it takes a while to get there. It will be worth it to know these facts well.

When you get 100% at least three times in a row, in less than 20 seconds, choose the next set of facts.
