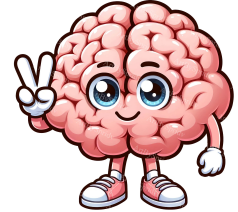
Study tips for students using FastFacts Math

Start with 2s

Tap on Create a List. Choose 2s. Grades 2-3: Addition Grades 4+: Multiplication.

Start with 2s even if you think you know them well.

- 1) See how fast you can get. This can be your target time for all lists.
- 2) Mastering this list will give you confidence to take on more lists.



Start with the Multiple Choice option. Answer quickly. Trust your brain.

Consider using the timer to help you answer quickly.

Many students make the mistake of counting or hesitating. It's important to trust your first response. Turn the timer off while you are learning. Turn it on to help you to answer quickly.

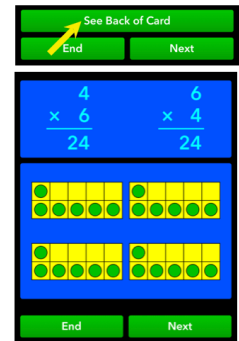
Incorrect answers are not mistakes. They are opportunities to learn.

If your answer is not correct or you run out of time, tap on See Back of Card.

Examine the graphics and think about the fact and ways to remember it.

Write and say both the question and answer.

Each time you do this, you learn the fact better.



Build a home practice routine.

Attach your practice routine to something you do every day, like eating dinner.

If you don't feel like practicing, commit to studying one list, one time.

Sometimes just taking that first step, gets you started on your way. From the song, Ready to Rock!
Set an alarm for an hour after dinner. This will remind you to practice if you forget.



Come up with a way to celebrate when you complete the final list.

Talk to your parents. Suggest something that will motivate you like pizza for dinner, going out for ice cream, more screen time, staying up late, etc.
